Anointing of the Sick: If you are ill or planning to enter the hospital and wish to be anointed, please call the parish office and make an appointment for anointing before you enter the hospital. Remember: Once you have been anointed, you do not need to be anointed again during the same illness unless several months have passed.

Parishioners with chronic illness or in advanced age are urged to attend morning Holy Mass and the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick on every Second Friday of the month.
