Thanks to all Parish families who have pledged to the Bishop’s Faith Appeal.

- 1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross**
- 2. Opening Prayers:** You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. (Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

- 3. Our Father. . . Hail Mary. . . and the Apostle's Creed**
- 4. Then on the Our Father beads say the following:**
Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- 5. On the ten small beads of each decade**
For the sake of His Sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 6. Repeat for the remaining decades**
- 7. Conclude with Holy God (repeat three times)**
Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

- 8. Closing Prayer:** Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
